

HVERHILL HERITAGE COMMISSION

Minutes — Thursday, May 26, 2011 – James Morrill Building, North Haverhill, NH

Attending: Jim Hobbs, Dick Ekwall, Wayne Fortier, Karen Griswold, Scott Moody

Chairman Hobbs, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that there was no meeting on April 28th because only a total of three people attended that night. Jim said he was trying to find people to be members of the Commission.

The treasury of the Commission stands at \$4595.10.

Dick Ekwall stated that no work was being done on the caboose presently because Rick Walling was out of town. As soon as he returns, he will get the windows done.

Jim has not figured out when he will do his show at the United Methodist Church in Woodsville. Wayne stated that he thought that Haverhill Academy would be having a reunion on July 9th and that might be a good time to have it.

He also said he had been turned down by nurseries as sponsors for the park. He has sent requests to Wal-Mart, Home Depot, Office Depot, and others for a \$25,000 per annum sponsorship. There is a nursery in the southern part of the state that will provide plants at cost.

Dick said that the Haverhill Garden Club was not interested in doing flowers for either end of the bridge from Wells River into Woodsville.

Karen asked Scott what was happening about the “Welcome to Woodsville” sign he had talked about. Scott says he has to get a cost estimate for building the sign and then will approach the precinct. Dick Guy said there was some money available.

Scott also mentioned that there was some granite piled up on the way to Haverhill Corner that might be of use. He will also email the Precinct to see if they will no longer be using the granite that was recently broken up on Pine Street.

Karen then stated to the group that she will be resigning from the Commission as of June 1, 2011.

With no further business to be discussed, Wayne moved we adjourn. This was seconded by Dick. The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
