**Granite Block Report from Jim Hobbs:**

- **Need to plan for a concrete slab as a foundation for blocks. Rick Walling offered to assist saying he thought we could do it ourselves.**

**Caboose Report from Dick Ekwall:**

- **Guest Rick Walling reports on the installation of the new windows. He discovered more hidden dry rot that had to be repaired before putting in the new windows.**
- **Dick Ekwall has been stripping the metal railing.**
- **The Cupola has some dry rot and will need to be repaired to insure against water getting in between the cupola and the base of the caboose. The chair asked Mr. Walling to work up an estimate to do this additional work as an addendum to his original bid. Chr. Hobbs will turn it over to TM English as soon as the estimate is completed.**

**Hazen report from Jim Hobbs**

- **Jim Hobbs reports that the workday on Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> was very productive with approx. 1 acre “bush-hogged in the lower level and approx. 1/2 acre around the foundation, entrance, and barn ramp.**
- **Wayne Fortier and Richard Patten removed 4 to 6 trees around the Hazen house foundation.**
- **Senator Forrester has been scheduled for a walk-thru tour of the property on July 11th at 10 am.**

**Jim Hobbs planted a Pussy Willow tree near the front step of the Hazen house.**

**\*\*\* Motion made by Dick Ekwall to appropriate \$100 for continued bush-hogging of the Hazen property. Motion seconded by Scott Moody. Motion approved.**
