Vallee ... A. H. Vallee operated a restaurant in the Music Hall building on Pleasant Street, between the original Odd Fellows building and Weeks Block on the corner of Pleasant and Central Streets. Vallee evidently ran the business for a few years before selling to Charles W. Johnson, from Wells River, in 1893.

Valley ... Mary A. Valley, widow of Henry Valley, is boarding at 50 Mill Street, the home of George Highland. (1919)

Van Heusen ... Beckus Van Heusen is an engineer for the B&M railroad. He and Edith C. Van Heusen have a house at 39 Ammonosuc Street. (1915 - 1937) Beck is retired and the Van Heusens' are living at 40 Ammonosuc Street. (1953 - 1958)

Varney ...

*** Fred W. Varney is a wiper in the B&M roundhouse. Fred and Gertrude Varney have a house at 171 Ammonoosuc Street. (1915) Fred is a turntable man in 1919.

*** Maurice F. Varney is a mail messenger and fireman in the B&M heat plant. He and Jennie M. Varney have a house at 171 Ammonosuc Street. (1915) (1919)

Valiquet ... Joseph A. Valiquet is a clerk at the Mulliken & Son Store on Central Street. He rooms at Mrs. E. J. Severance's on Walnut Street. (1915).

Veayo ... George Veayo is working in Portland, Maine, in the shipyards. (1943) He also worked at the Dandy diner, for a while. George is a partner in Cromwell and Veayo, a garage-gas station in Wells River, Vermont.

George and Doris H. Veayo live at the foot of Clay Hill at 50 South Court Street.(1953 - 1958) This building (home) was built by John Woods for a little over \$200.00, and was the first school house in Woodsville, known as the Clay Hill School. The Veayos had two children ... Carole and Judith. Carole has retired from years of loyalty to Woodsville High School. Judy is married to Chuck Gandin and helps run Gandin Bros. in South Ryegate, Vt.

Veilie ... Clark Veilie is a lineman for the NET &T Company. He boards at 7 Smith Street, the home of Albert Saulte. (1919)

*** Philip Vergani is clerk in Carlo Verganis's Fruit Store. Philip rooms with the Vergani's on Ammonoosuc Street. (1915) Philip Vergani has removed to Orleans, Vermont. (1919)


